Stuttgart, Frankfurt, June 30, 2011: After three successful days, LOPE-C 2011 – international conference and exhibition for organic and printed electronics - has come to a close with an exhibition space up to 30% on last year. From June 28-30, 2011 in Frankfurt, 91 companies demonstrated, on a display area of 1,500 square meters, their latest developments and products in the field of organic and printed electronics.
